


# FBC Cleveland January Book Club

### How our January Book Club will work:

1. Obtain your copy of *The Calvary Road* by Roy Hession. It can be purchased at church for \$6, or downloaded in e-book/PDF form. To find *The Calvary Road* for free in e-book or PDF form, search (google, bing, etc) "The Calvary Road Roy Hession" through your computer. It will be found in both e-book form and PDF form (to be used by those who don't have an e-book reader, or an e-book app on your devices). It is a short book, so you could easily print the free PDF and have a paper copy of this book.
2. Read the book on your own time during the remainder of the month of January. The book contains eleven short chapters, including the introduction. Read and re-read one chapter a day, asking the Lord to speak personally to you through these topics. You will best remember and retain the information if you take notes on what God is saying to you, and if you will write down your response back to Him. In other words, read, write, and respond. This way, you are letting God's truths have a chance to marinate within your heart.
3. Make plans to join the discussion group meeting held on January 26 at 5pm (locations TBA). Men and women will meet separately and will share and discuss how these truths impacted life and brought revival.

Seeking the Lord's work in your life through the pages of this little book is a wonderful way to begin each new year. You are being prayed for as you journey with Jesus down *The Calvary Road*.
